The Village Board of Fairmont, Nebraska met in regular session on Monday, December 13th, 2021 at 7:00p.m. at the Fairmont Village Hall, 635 6th Ave., Fairmont NE. Chairperson Donald A Moses called the meeting to order. Clerk/Treasurer Karen Margheim recorded the minutes. Funding opportunities for the Water System Preliminary Engineering Report Results

Terry Meier, JEO Consulting Group, Inc. was present to discuss the results of the Water System Preliminary Engineering Report Results and the option which may appeal mostly to the council and funding. The State of Nebraska is offering Loan Forgiveness for certain water projects. Terry encouraged the Village of Fairmont to apply to see the amount of funds we may receive even if we choose not pursue any options. He indicated we don't have to agree to the State of Nebraska's decision if it isn't a good fit for our budget. After some discussion, the Board gave Terry the approval to complete a pre-application for funding a water treatment plant. The Opinion of Cost for this project is \$2,249,844.

Paving Improvement-Road 12 & Road F Project Amendment #2-JEO Consulting Group, Inc.

Andrew Wilhausen was present to review Amendment #2 for the Road Improvement Project. The amendment included an increased cost amount of \$48,500. The anticipated start date will be some time in the spring when the ground is good. Late January or early February a preconstruction meeting will be scheduled. A motion to approve Amendment #2 was made by Moses, seconded by Jarosz. Roll call vote — 5 ayes, 0 nays. Motion approved.
