



2023 Fairmont Community Club Scholarship

Fairmont, NE

The Fairmont Community Club will offer a \$500.00 scholarship to a graduating senior that has legal residency of Fairmont, NE. The scholarship will be paid at the conclusion of the 2023 Fall Semester once an official transcript is provided to the Fairmont Community Club. (If the selected recipient attends a 2-year school, the scholarship will be paid upon completion of two academic quarters.) The scholarship recipient must have at least at a 2.5 GPA to receive the scholarship payment. An alternate will be named, and should the recipient not fulfill the requirements, the scholarship will be offered to the alternate, given the alternate also meets all scholarship requirements.

Recipient will be required to contact the Fairmont Community Club to collect their scholarship. If not collected by January 15 of the second semester, the scholarship will be void. The deadline for collection of scholarship funds (for the alternate) will be January 30.
