Snow Removal Reminder

Village Code #8-201 states the sidewalks within the business district shall be cleaned within five hours after the cessation of a storm, unless the storm or fall of snow shall have taken place during the night, in which case the sidewalk shall be cleaned before 8:30 a.m. the following day.

Sidewalks within the residential areas of the Municipality shall be cleaned within 24 hours after the cessation of the storm. Thank you for your cooperation with snow removal.

Priority areas for village maintenance snow removal are the downtown area, fire barn and rescue unit building, school area and nursing home. After these areas have been cleared, then snow removal continues in the residential areas.


Winter is here — bundle up that house to save on heating bills

- Open curtains on your south-facing windows during the day to allow sunlight to heat your home, and close them at night to reduce the chill from cold windows.

- When you are home, set your thermostat to as low as comfortable. When you go to bed, turn your thermostat back about 10 degrees to save around 10 percent a year on your heating and cooling bills.

- Cover drafty windows by using a heavy-duty, clear plastic sheet on a frame or tape clear plastic window film to the inside of your window frames during the colder months.

- Use LED lights to reduce the cost of holiday lighting.

No building or structure or part of a building or structure shall be erected, constructed, reconstructed, replaced, moved or structurally altered without first obtaining a zoning permit.

This permit may be obtained from the Fillmore County Zoning web site (www.fillmorecounty.org) by clicking on the "Offices" tab then clicking on the "Zon-

Recycling update

All residents are encouraged to take advantage of the compartmentalized recycling trailer, located just south of the existing recycling semi-trailer at the corner of 1st Ave. and E Street.



Please pay attention to the signage on each trailer to assist you with the proper placement of your recyclable items.

Items for the compartmentalized recycling trailer include newspapers, magazines, tin cans, aluminum cans, #1 and #2 plastics and corrugated cardboard. Please flatten out your cardboard boxes. Paperboard (cake mix box, etc.) is not accepted.
